Part of Triangle Nursery School, 25 Clapham, Crescent, SW4 7JQ.

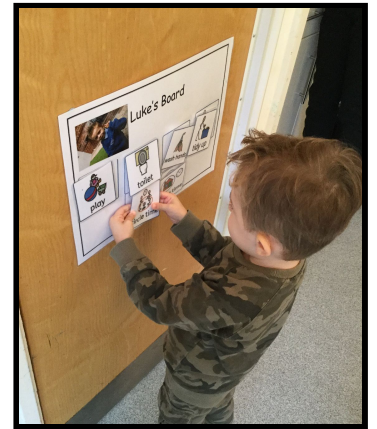
We are an inclusive and well-resourced provision for up to 6 children aged 2-5 years with complex additional needs. We offer a calm and nurturing space that encourages children to be confident, independent and active learners.

A qualified teacher leads a team of experienced and dedicated staff to deliver interventions and support to enable children to meet their developmental milestones, using a combination of motivating and developmentally appropriate resources and highly effective intervention and support strategies.

Our nurture provision is fully integrated within our nursery environment. This allows flexibility for children to move around the whole environment and the potential to support transition into the main nursery.

This provision may be appropriate for your child if they present with any of the following profiles:

- Children with 12+ months developmental delay.
- Children with very early communication skills, including expressive and receptive language who would benefit from intensive support to develop their attention and focus.
- Children who have specific sensory needs, or those who may display sensory overload in louder or busier environments.
- Children who require significant additional support with their self care and independence, including toileting, dressing and eating.
- Children who have a physical disability, including those who are visually or auditory impaired, and those with limited mobility and physical impairments.
- Children who have limited emotional regulation and display difficulties with separation anxiety.
